

Education for all: The Nordic Model

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In Finland Nordic model in education has redeveloped many times. This was happened because of the need of the policy the country was following and each phase has redefined the education over the period. The Nordic model of education has followed the path of creating the nation in 1860 to creating a democracy in 1921, to deepening the democracy in 1970. In 1990, Neoliberalism created the impact on schooling too.
